Enroll in Dual Enrollment and earn college credit while you are still in high school!

In a hurry to start college? Dual Enrollment is your opportunity to get a jump start on your college career and see what it is like to be a student at Alabama Southern. Dual Enrollment allows qualified students the opportunity to receive both high school credit and college credit through Alabama Southern.

What is Dual Enrollment?

Dual Enrollment offers a focused, efficient and cost-effective plan to earn college credit from Alabama Southern Community College, a local and nationally recognized leader among community colleges.

Dual Enrollment students gain early exposure to the college learning environment and positive reinforcement of learning skills. Students who complete the program can enter college at the sophomore level after high school graduation. College credits earned through dual enrollment can be applied toward college graduation and can be transferred to other colleges and universities.

We also offer a variety of Dual Enrollment Technical Programs that prepare students to be a part of Southwest Alabama's economic boom. These programs qualify you for a great job in some of our area's top industries.

Dual Enrollment Process

How do I get started?

- To be eligible for dual enrollment you must:
- Meet the admission requirements of Alabama Southern.
 - Have a B average in completed high school courses.
 - Be in grade 11 or 12.
 - Have appropriate scores on the ACT or the ASSET placement test.
 - Have written approval from your school's counselor, principal and the local superintendent of education. Before you consider dual enrollment as an option, Alabama Southern encourages you to consult with your high school counselor to determine if this option is the best for you.

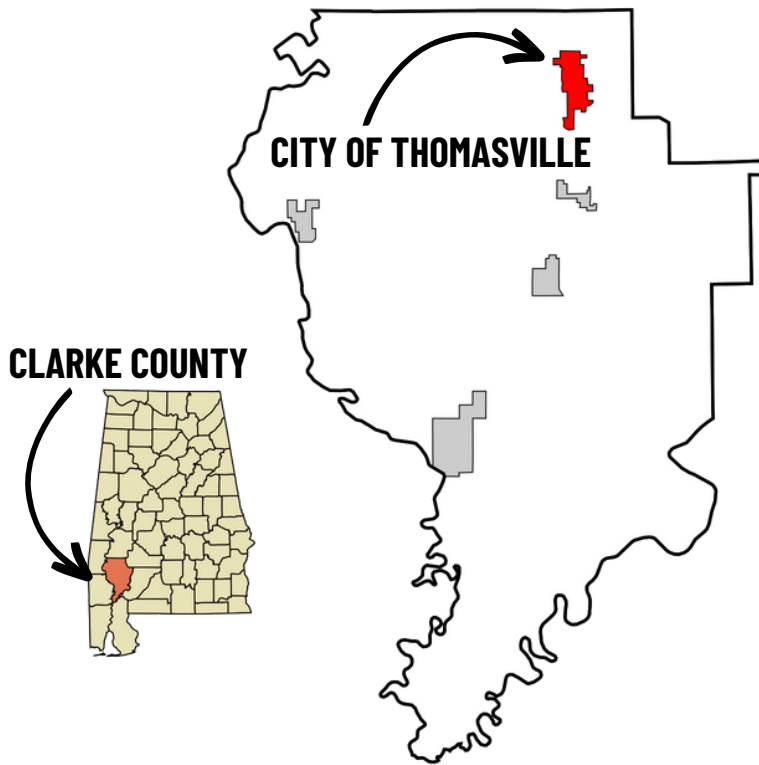

LOCATION



Thomasville has proven to be an excellent location for industries with easy access to multiple forms of transportation. With the Port of Mobile located only 90 miles from Thomasville and Norfolk Southern Railroad access that extends from Mobile to our community and beyond, our industries are capable of International Trade as well.

Not only are industries able to transport goods by water and rail, we also have US Highway 43 which is a four-lane highway running through Thomasville from I-65 in Mobile County to I-59 providing links to two more interstates, I-10 and I-20.

Thomasville has developed four (4) industrial parks and built our second Speculative Building, a 50,000 sq. ft. building expandable to 200,000 sq. ft. in our South Industrial Park. Our community is a Favored Geographic Area offering a program of lower investment and job creation thresholds to take advantage of Alabama's Capital Tax Credits.

THE NEW WEST ALABAMA CORRIDOR.

Thomasville Public Library and the City of Thomasville received a \$1.26 million grant to greatly expand their Library/Career Readiness Center and relocate it into Historic Downtown Thomasville. This 3.2-million-dollar project was opened to the public on June 30th, 2023 as Thomasville's Public Library/Career Readiness Center/Museum.

NEW REGIONAL AIRPORT TO BE DEVELOPED IN THOMASVILLE, AL!



The establishment of the new Southwest Alabama Regional Airport is moving forward with much of the preparatory work complete. The facilities' Feasibility and Site Identification studies are complete and the Environment Assessment, Airport Layout Plan and Capital Improvement Plan are under final review with the Federal Aviation Administration. Upon approval, land acquisition shall commence with construction to follow shortly thereafter. The facility will serve as a regional airport for the Thomasville, Grove Hill and Clarke County communities and shall be configured to support business jet and turbo-prop aircraft as well as all smaller fixed wing aircraft and helicopters. The airport will open with a 5,000' x 75' runway with high quality instrument procedures as well as the associated supporting infrastructure (taxiways, aprons, vehicular access, etc). The airport has been located and configured to be expandable to meet the needs of the region.

FIRST US BANK donated the old Bedsole Building in Downtown Thomasville to be the home of the new and improved Thomasville Public Library.

While the total renovation and construction of the facility is expected to cost \$3.4 million, thanks to a DRA Grant, only \$778,620 is needed to be raised locally.

Our goal is to provide a safe place for children to grow and play; provide classes and programs for adults to continue lifelong learning and gather together; offer newly released materials and best sellers; be a social hub, a learning center, a technological showcase, a job seekers haven, and a partner to local businesses.

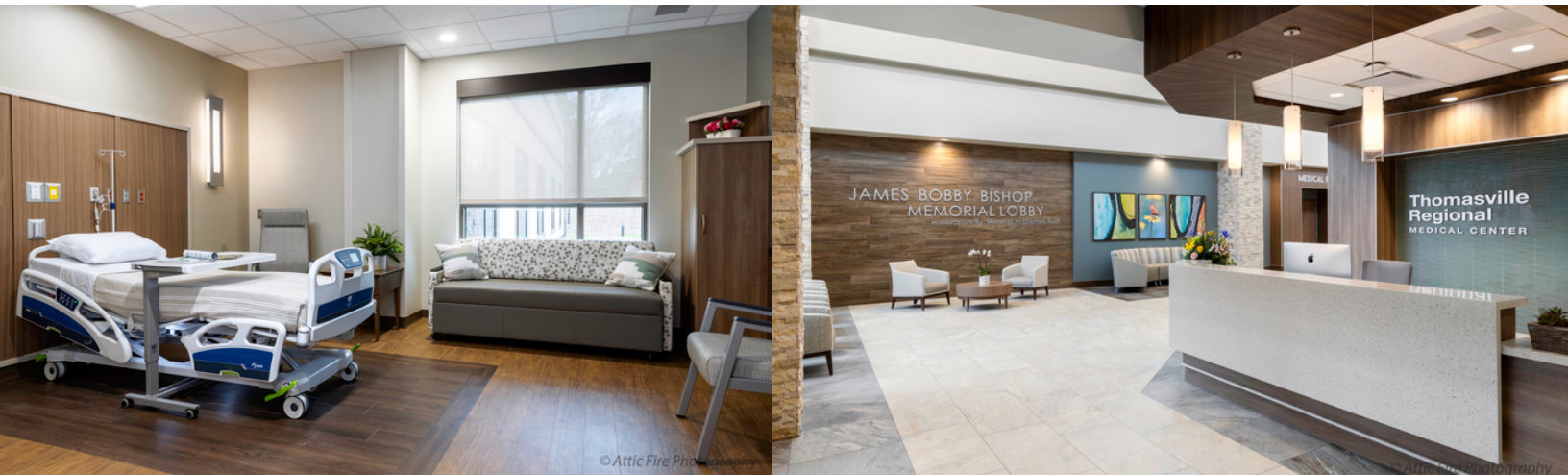

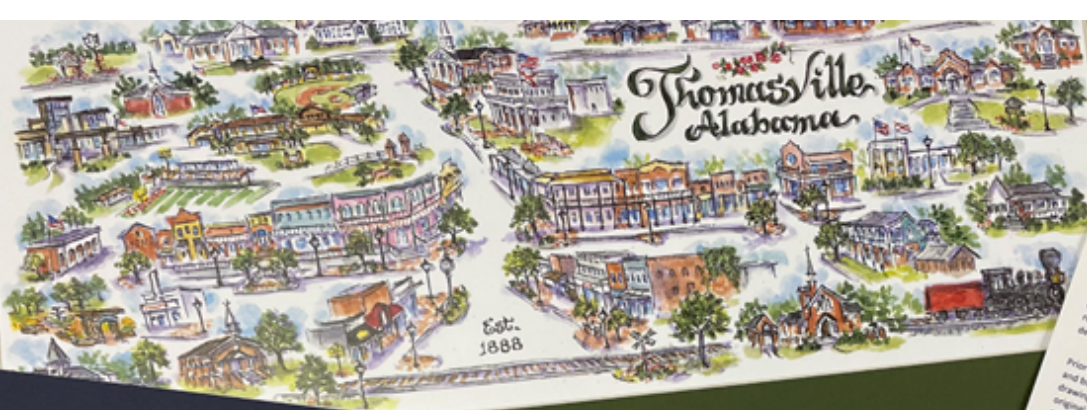

She does a highly detailed drawing in pen and ink, then adds color with watercolor washes. The original artwork can take from 100 to 200 hours to complete. The personally signed and numbered each print. Prints are custom matted and sized to fit ready-made frames.
